# General notices

## CELEBRATING LENT

Our Lenten season has begun with many parishioners from both parishes joining in the celebrations of Ash Wednesday during the week. There are many opportunities for us to enter into the Lenten call for prayer, almsgiving, fasting. Details of Church teaching on Lent have been posted at both parish churches.

One significant tradition in the church is the Project Compassion initiative. Through the donations made in the boxes and envelopes provided by Caritas, many disadvantaged people throughout the world are given much needed financial support. Caritas as an agency are very proud of their record in seeing that the majority of money donated goes directly to the needy. This is in contrast to many other welfare agencies that have very high financial overheads. Another positive aspect of the work Caritas does is that they work with the people who actually live in the areas requiring financial support, enabling them to have input into their needs rather than determining the needs of the recipient countries from afar. We commend their good works to you in this Lenten season.

Opportunities for prayer provided in Lent include the weekly Stations of the Cross each Friday night offered in both parishes. This is in addition to the many "regular" opportunities outside Mass for private and devotional prayer. In addition, you may like to consider the opportunities offered by participating in one of the Lenten Programs offered. These programs enable the participants to reflect upon and discuss the weekly gospels during Lent.

You will notice that Lent is a time when we simplify our lives and our liturgy so as to prepare for the coming celebrations of the Passion, death and Resurrection of Jesus in the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday). Making Sacrifices and letting go of the negative aspects in our life as well as fasting and abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are ways we can do this. Our church becomes more stark. The colour purple is traditionally associated with mourning or lament and a new beginning/fresh start. Flowers have been removed from the church. Our prayers and singing in the Mass are simplified. All this as we take time to renew our focus on our faith and the life, death and Resurrection of Jesus, as well as in preparation for the joy and colour of our Easter celebrations.
