### WHAT'S HAPPENING...

On the afternoon of 14th February, our RCIA candidates from both parishes attended the Rite of Election ceremony at St. Patrick's Cathedral. It was an opportunity for the candidates from across Melbourne Archdiocese to get together for this special ceremony. The Cathedral was filled, with some 2,000 people in attendance. Cathy Dowling, representing Resurrection, did a reading, whilst St. A's candidates had the pleasure of sharing afternoon tea with Bishop Terry Curtin earlier in the week. For the candidates, it is a beautiful reminder that they are part of something so much bigger than their local parish community. There is an excitement at travelling together on the parish bus, being in the Cathedral (often their first visit), and having a photo with the Bishop. Thanks to our RCIA Teams who care for our candidates with great love and diligence.

On Saturday morning (5th March), we held the combined Parish Pastoral Council Discernment Day for parishioners who are considering a position on their Parish Pastoral Council. We had a lovely morning with great conversation, and insight offered by current members. Please keep our potential new members in prayer as they discern in the coming days whether it is right for them to proceed with their nomination.

At Resurrection, the Little Chapel renovations begin on Monday. The facilities will be upgraded and include a kitchen

and toilet facilities. Therefore, the toilets and sacristy area in the Little Chapel will be unavailable for several weeks. Toilets in the Parish Centre will be open during Mass times.

Parishioners are now encouraged to start thinking about which ceremonies you will be attending during Holy Week and to consider how you would like to serve our community during this time. St. Anthony's sign up sheets for Holy Week are in the church foyer this weekend; Resurrection sign up sheets will be available soon. Please note: Readers and Special Ministers need to be on the weekend roster in order to minister at the Easter ceremonies.

Please keep in prayer our Year 5 and 6 children from Resurrection parish school; they will be on camp in Canberra this week.

At St. Anthony's, the annual Harmony Day celebration will be on Friday 18th March. All parishioners are warmly invited to attend and participate in the day's many events. It will be an extra special day as it falls within our 60th anniversary celebrations. Further details inside the bulletin.

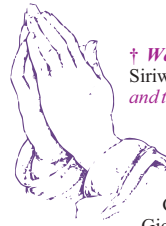
