**PENTECOST SUNDAY
THE GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**

Grace (*if you haven't met her*) is the theological term for the Holy Spirit. She is the breath of everything that exists. She is the Divine Energy fuelling all of Creation. She is invincible Love being visible. She is the 'deep within' of every human being. She is our inner Life Companion. She longs to live our lives with us.

True Spirituality is my total way of living... how I 'live out of the spirit' in my reality. It's about becoming more and more in touch with my own "holy ground", with the spirit, Grace, living deep within me. It's about allowing Grace to become my Life Companion, to teach and enlighten me, direct and challenge me, strengthen and gentle me, en-peace and en-joy me – *'to melt me, mould me, fill me, use me'* in my everyday reality.

Spirituality permeates all my Relationships... with God, myself, others, and all of Creation. It is 'mystical' in its simplest, deepest sense.

It's affected by my personality, upbringing, social, cultural and religious environments. It's founded on my basic beliefs... and flows into my perceptions, attitudes, opinions, values, behaviours, goals in life.

Although connected, it's different from my Faith, my Religion or my Theology. Religions are human constructions designed to

'bind us back' (religare) to God. Theology is ideas, words about God; The experts'

Grace, and the truth about God, and ourselves as God's beloved sons and daughters, have been revealed to us through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus.

It is not so much by dying for us that Jesus 'saves' us. Like the rest of us, Jesus had to pass through suffering and death. He saves us by letting us know who we truly are, and showing us how to become our truest Selves, by allowing the Spirit within us to take over our lives more and more.

Like Jesus, we can grow in touching the spirit deep within us, listening to her wisdom, drawing on her energy, her strength, her loving kindness, her limitless gifts, as we live day by day.

“If you keep listening to my word... you will come to know the Truth and the Truth will set you free.” (John 8:31-32)
