**FAMILIES DOING IT TOUGH**

Last Thursday evening, the Dandenong Deanery hosted an evening with guest speaker Mayor; Roz Blades. Roz spoke of the many issues facing families, informing us that Dandenong is the most multi-cultural community in Australia with thirty naturalisations every month. This growth comes with many gifts but also challenges. Federal funding has been cut back to support the poor. Roz spoke of the need for ordinary people to speak up and provide compassion to those in need. No one deserves to be hungry – whatever the reason. Roz reminded us not to “judge” but to “help”. The council is pro-active in soliciting support from local businesses to provide housing and services to those in need and our parishes should be very proud for having 10 and 27 units providing housing for those on low income.

So what can we do to be of service.....some ideas!

Resurrection Social Justice Group (RES-ACTION) are working on a range of initiatives to support those doing it tough (see notice inside newsletter).

**ST VINCENT DE PAUL.** Our local branches at Resurrection and St Anthony's are just a call away if you need assistance or if you can help with non-perishable food items.

**KEYSBOROUGH LEARNING CENTRE** provides food relief and a range of support services for those experiencing hardship. Young Vinnies are very pro-active in supplying financial support and food supplies.

**JOEY'S VAN.** Many of our parishioners, and deanery parishes support this initiative, (especially our youth) going out to feed the homeless in our area.

**BREAD.** Parishioners are involved in the collection and sorting to take to families in need.

### RCIA PROGRAM (RES)

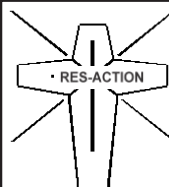
Please note that the RCIA Program will now commence on Sunday 4th August after the 11am Mass with a shared lunch in the Parish centre.
