### WHAT'S HAPPENING...

I'm sure we have all heard the statement, one step forward and two steps backwards. At the end of July we announced the good news at St Anthony's that we had received the necessary approval to proceed with our plans to renovate our Church and Parish Centre, and we had received the approval for our loan. In getting to this stage we have met several challenges which has led to our plans being well behind our original schedule.

Late last week we received the necessary documentation from our building surveyor to allow us to proceed to tender for builders. Unfortunately the costings of both Church and Parish Centre have come in higher than we had anticipated. Brian and Martin both met with Mark our architect for a tough meeting to see where the price can be brought back to our approved amount.

Our conversation to date is that we will maintain most of our Church renovations. There will be an opportunity for us to fundraise for the Church as individuals, families, community groups and fundraising as a Parish community e.g. dances etc. A list of items that will be able to be purchased or fundraised for will be available soon.

It was decided to rethink the parish centre, using the external shell of most of the current building, building a new gathering space out the front of our parish centre, and remaining the current space for our parish offices and administration.

We believe that we will be able to bring this price down so that we can go out to tender soon. As our newsletter goes to print we are about to meet with Mark our Architect and the Diocesan support person.

In recent years at Resurrection we have been holding conversations with Villa Maria Catholic Homes (VMCH) about the prospect of leasing some of our Parish land to develop an Aged Care facility. At this stage our conversation is looking at the possibility of building independent units of 2 or 3 bedrooms. Unfortunately we don't have the space to build a high care unit.

At our meeting last week VMCH said the next stage of our discernment was to host a community meeting to discuss "what are the needs of people in our community and surrounding district". We also need to see if there is a need for such a facility. This will be discussed at an information night. All interested parties are welcome and encouraged to attend. If there is little interest it will not proceed. VMCH will inform those interested of what their community facilities consist of and the possible design and costings

All who are interested, would like to know more and would like to feed into this Focus Group early conversation, are invited to a meeting on Thursday 29th August at 7pm in the Little Chapel. Supper will be provided. All are Welcome.

In 2017-2018 the ministry has:

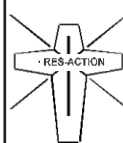
- Supported 5,500 families and young people with early intervention services

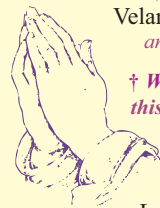
