BUSHFIRE RECOVERY APPEAL 2020



The Bushfire Recovery Appeal 2020 is a partnership between CatholicCare, the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne and the Diocese of Sale. It is an opportunity for the Catholic community to stand in solidarity with families and communities devastated by the 2020 bushfires in East Gippsland. Disaster recovery is a long process, and CatholicCare's role will begin when the immediate crisis is over and the emergency response teams have left. Commencing 16 February, this Appeal aims to raise \$2.5 million to fund the delivery of a Bushfire Community Recovery Service in East Gippsland, which will support families and communities for up to three years providing therapeutic counselling, community development and pastoral care for bushfire-affected communities in East Gippsland. Details regarding how to donate will be available in the Parish over the coming fortnight.
