### WHAT'S HAPPENING...

#### THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

More than 1,100 people gathered at St Patrick's Cathedral last Sunday afternoon for the annual Rite of Election, a key step in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) process. It is at this Rite that those preparing to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation at Easter are presented to the Archbishop and the wider community.

From St. Anthony's we have three catechumens and Resurrection have two. They were excited to join this ceremony. Check our social media for some photos.

Every year, men and women who wish to join the Catholic Church are invited to 'come and see' through the RCIA process, the first step of which enables them to get to know Jesus through the gospels. The second step on the RCIA journey is a liturgical rite during which the Church formally acknowledges the catechumens' readiness for the Sacraments of Initiation and their names are inscribed into the Book of Elect.

Over 55 parishes across the Archdiocese of Melbourne were represented at this year's Rite of Election, with the catechumens (*those who are preparing for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist*)

and candidates (*those who have already been baptised—in the Catholic Church or in other Christian traditions—but have not yet come to the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist*) gathering at St Patrick's Cathedral to listen to the Word of God and make public their commitment to persevere on their journey towards full communion with the Catholic Church this Easter.

Accompanied by their RCIA sponsor or godparent, fellow parishioners, family and friends, the catechumens and candidates were welcomed by Archbishop Peter A. Comensoli, who affirmed them in their openness to embark on a lifelong journey of Christian discipleship. Let us keep them in our prayer.

With the current situation with corona virus we have ceased drinking from the Cup/Chalice.
