WHAT'S HAPPENING...

Last Friday afternoon Fr Martin and I attended our meeting at the Archdiocese of Melbourne, where we met with Mr Dao Tran of the Archdiocese and Mr Mark Meaden, our Architect, as we opened the five Tenders that have reviewed our plans and submitted their quotes. We are happy to announce that three of these Tenders have come in very close to our costings. Mark has been meeting with those three tenderers, checking that their costings are to our liking and meet our needs. The successful tender will be announced shortly.

We will remain in our Church for Easter and then move into the hall, which we will set up as our Church for the time while our site is under construction. To assist us, Dao Tran, the Archdiocesan building expert, will attend all our building site meetings during the construction period. We have been fortunate that Dao has been part of our process from the start, guiding us along the way. We certainly appreciate not only his knowledge as an architect, but also his knowledge of Archdiocesan Building Policy, needs, requirements and expectations.

To the surprise of many Fr Yon has had a week in Melbourne. Fortunately he was able to attend our regular Tuesday Staff/Team lunch at Resurrection. Tuesday was also Yon's 33 Birthday. We shared a lovely lunch and had a birthday cake for him. On Wednesday morning Yon concelebrated with Martin the 9.30 Mass at St Anthony's, where he stayed around for some time speaking with Parishioners. He has then had commitments with his order. Yon returned to Brisbane on Saturday for his final

week at his Parish. He will then go to his new appointment as assistant Priest to Emerald Parish in the Diocese of Rockhampton Queensland. We wish Yon well in his new appointment.

Several weeks ago I was asked by the Rector of the Seminary, Fr Denis Stanley, to consult with our Parish team at Resurrection to see if we were able to host a Seminarian. John Jery is a fourth year Seminarian who has been appointed to us. He came out and met the team on Friday. He will attend each Friday for the remainder of this term and next. He will be present for the whole of our Easter celebrations. Then he will be with us from July to Christmas Day. I'm sure you will make him welcome when you meet him. Let's keep John and all our Seminararians in prayer.
