AUSTRALIA UNITES TO CONFRONT THE CHALLENGE OF COVID-19.

Wednesday morning we woke up to Prime Minister Morrison calling for the whole of Australia to unite as one to meet the challenge of this virus and the care of one another. By late afternoon the Victorian Catholic Bishops had announced our Church's response to this challenge - that we will cease to meet publicly as a faith community, so as to prevent the spread of the virus among those with whom we worship. We the Catholic Community of Victoria will work together with the whole of Australia to defeat this virus.

This decision will be very challenging for many of us. Already, I'm aware of three couples with weddings planned in the near future who have sadly made the decision to postpone their Wedding till later in the year. Our families who will need to prepare Funerals during this time will be limited to a maximum of 100 mourners. Fr Peter Robinson, a very respected Priest in the Archdiocese, died last weekend. His family are having a private funeral and his communities will gather later in the year for a Memorial Mass. This is a time for us to think outside the square, to be creative on how we are called to celebrate and live life.

For many of our Faith Community we love our regular Mass and those we gather with, to pray and share our faith. Many of us gather with our friends, where we support and celebrate life with each other and share one another's joy and sorrows. We will miss our community and the life we share. Fortunately we will still have the opportunity to pray with and read our Scriptures on line or from our Bible or Mass book. Unfortunately we will not be able to receive Eucharist, our weekly source of nourishment, food for the journey of the week ahead. We will attempt to leave our Churches open for the morning for you to enter for private prayer. Again numbers will

not be able to exceed 100 at this time and we will amend these practices as the Government and Bishops advise.

Where possible may you try to remain in contact with one another via phone or email. Life will be isolating enough. Our Parish staff will attempt to work for as long as we can. We ask you to keep us informed of what is happening in your life. If you need to speak to our Parish Team or a Priest, please leave a message at the Parish and one of our Team will respond to you as quickly as we can.

In this difficult time may we remain faithful in prayer, giving ourselves opportunity to pray, to be still and reflect on life and all that is sacred. May we pray for all who have died, those who are currently infected, the many who have recovered and all in our medical professions and research. We look forward to the day when Australia and our World are Corona free. Till then may we remain vigilant in our care of self and one another. May we be open, calm and just in all our interactions, and trusting in God.
