**WHAT'S HAPPENING...**

This time last week we were thinking how fast the new Government restrictions came in. Many people thought they didn't apply to them, thinking it was meant for the elderly and vulnerable of our country. Slowly we are all learning that this is for the benefit of ALL Australians. Many of us were taken by surprise when Prime Minister Morrison came out on Tuesday night with new, tighter restrictions.

For us as people of faith, our places of worship were only open last week for private prayers. Baptisms, weddings and funerals were permitted with no more than 100 guests. The new regulations, which came into effect at midnight Wednesday, means our places of worship are now closed. Weddings can now only be celebrated with the couple, 2 witnesses and Priest/Deacon. Funerals can only be celebrated with ten people in attendance, including the Priest. Baptisms will now be held over till the virus is over, unless it is for an emergency.

Our Parish Team has been meeting regularly during this time attempting to address the many questions that arise. The Archdiocese is in regular contact with all Parishes with updates, interpretations and support. Our Parish Teams along with our Parish Pastoral Councils present and past, have divided up our census details and have started phoning our Parishioners, to touch base and see how you are going.

We believe phone contact is very important as we are aware some people are in lock down and feel very isolated and fearful. You are most welcome to email or phone the Parish if you are in need - you don't have to wait for our phone call. If you haven't

filled in a census card recently then we most likely won't have your latest contact details. If you don't hear from the Parish within the next two weeks it means we need you to phone or email us with your correct contact details.

Watching the news is becoming very depressing, hearing the world and Australian statistics from the Corona virus. It was so sad seeing the many men and women who have lost their jobs - we're now queuing up to enrol for Government benefits. People's lives have changed drastically within days. School holidays have begun early, but sadly there is no money or places open for entertainment. For some families holidaying in their home will have many challenges, all living in close confines. For those experiencing family violence, anxiety will be high.

Our Parishes are here for you, whatever your need. Hopefully between us we will find a solution or at least give you a listening heart and ear. Please feel free to phone or email the Parish and one of the team will get back to you ASAP. For those fortunate to still be employed, work to your best ability and make the most of this opportunity. We are delighted for you. You having a job will lift the hearts of many. Don't take it for granted.

May we all remain in contact with family, friends and your faith community. May we continue in our relationship with God, may we pray for our World, Australia, family and friends and the most vulnerable of our time. Emmanuel, God is with us. Be gentle this week,
